General Information

Registration

Your official Jackson County 2005 Special Election Voters' Pamphlet is mailed to every household in the County, regardless of your registration status. If you need to register or update your current registration, you can find the necessary information and forms at www.sos.state.or.us/elections/votreg/vreg.htm, at your local post office, or in your Quest Dex phone directory. All new registrants in the county who mail their registration cards via the United States Postal service must include a copy of a valid form of identification. Sufficient identification is described on the registration form.

New voter registration cut-off for this election is April 26, 2005. If you complete and return a voter registration card updating your home address and/or mailing address after April 26th, you must request that a ballot be mailed to you or go to the office to get your ballot. If you have any questions regarding the status of your voter registration contact the Elections Department at 774-6148. *Ballots are not forwarded.*

Districts

This pamphlet includes information for **all** of the voting districts of Jackson County. Your ballot will only include the districts/zones that you are eligible to vote on. Ballots will be mailed Friday, April 29th. If you have any questions about what you will be voting on contact the Elections Department at 774-6148.

While the candidates' statements and information for the same office are listed alphabetically by their last name in this pamphlet, they will be in a different order on your ballot. Pursuant to ORS 254.155, the Secretary of State is required to complete a random order of the letters of the alphabet to determine the order in which the names of candidates appear on the ballot.

BALLOT TITLE

15-61 ANNEXATION OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE TO ROGUE VALLEY SEWER SERVICES (RVS)

QUESTION: Shall the City of Jacksonville annex into the services of Rogue Valley Sewer Services (RVS)?

SUMMARY: RVS is currently providing sewer services to Jacksonville by contract. Voters are being asked if the city should become part of RVS so that RVS will continue to provide sewer service and so the citizens of Jacksonville will have the right to vote in RVS elections.

RVS began providing sewer services in July, 2003. Since then, it:

- Inspected all maintenance lines;
- Identified 109 sections needing repair and fixed 43 sections with the highest priority;
- Replaced 2800 feet of sewer lines; and
- Spent over twice as much on city projects, maintenance and treatment than the total amount paid by city rate-payers.

Service rates **will not** be increased as a result of this annexation.

Eagle Point and Central Point annexed into RVS in 1998 and 2000 with over 85% voter approval, so that their citizens would continue receiving sewer service and participate in RVS elections.

Annexation gives Jacksonville residents representation in RVS decision making. Jacksonville City Council and RVS Board of Directors adopted resolutions supporting this annexation. A YES vote will continue this partnership.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This measure would add the City of Jacksonville to the boundaries of Rogue Valley Sewer Services, RVS. As a regional provider of sanitary sewer service, RVS provides service to the cities of Central Point, Eagle Point, Phoenix, Talent, parts of Medford and much of the unincorporated areas between these cities. RVS is a local government special district, governed by a five member elected Board of Directors.


If this measure is approved, Jacksonville residents would be able to vote on RVS measures as well as serve on the Board and other governing committees of RVS.

In 2003, the City Staff recommended to the City Council that sanitary services be provided by RVS. At that time, the City Council unanimously approved such a contract with RVS, planning to ask the voters in a couple years to decide if the City should become a part of RVS via annexation. Earlier this year, the City Council voted to have this election in May of 2005. Again, this vote was unanimous.

During the last 21 months, RVS has been able to examine all of the sewer lines throughout the City and determine that many are in danger of failing. In order to repair and replace the worst problem areas, RVS is supplementing revenues from city rate payers with its own resources.

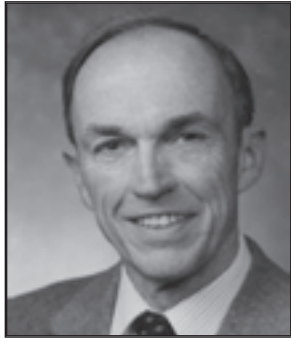
Sewer rates **will not** increase as a result of this annexation.

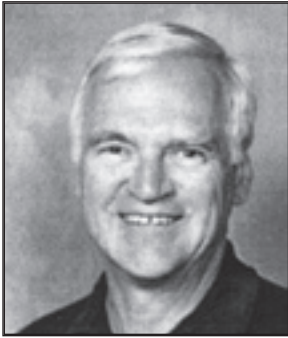

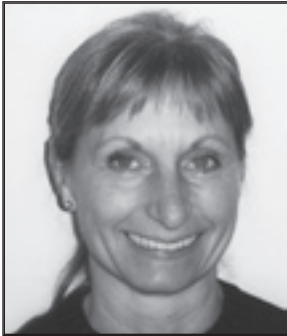
I feel privileged to have grown up in Ashland. During the last decade I have helped contribute to the excellence of our schools. My energy will continue to help our schools for the next four years.
